**Test of Metal
Brings Flow to
Gearjammer**

Squamish—Test of Metal Inc, in partnership with Mad March Racing, announced the creation of “Flow,” an exciting new downhill race in Squamish.

“Flow” will be held on Squamish’s newest trail, Half Nelson, on Friday, July 23, 2010, the weekend of Squamish’s second largest mountain bike race, the GearJammer.

“Gearjammer weekend promises to be another big mountain biking weekend in Squamish,” said race director Dave Gillie, “and Half Nelson is just the perfect trail to have this race. We’ll see some amazing speed.”

Half-Nelson, the first BC Government funded trail in Squamish, is a fast 3.4 kilometre pump-track style downhill course.

“Flow” is limited to 120 riders leaving in one minute intervals. The race is expected to sell out quickly.
